

MANITOBA SHUFFLEBOARD ASSOCIATION HALL OF FAME

The Manitoba Shuffleboard Association (MSA) Hall of Fame Committee will consist of three (3) members:

Two members every 2 years – nominated at the AGM

One member every 1 year – nominated at the AGM

After the initial first 2 years, there will annually be 1 new member to the Committee, and in accordance with the guidelines of at least 3 members from 3 different Teams and 2 different divisions.

A Hall of Fame (HOF) nomination may be presented by any active MSA player and within the guidelines noted below.

The HOF Committee will:

1. Consider, nominate and induct those players from the MSA charter provided the player/builder qualifies.
2. Ask the nominator to assist the HOF Committee with the brochure content ie. History, picture(s), etc.
3. Request the MSA purchase a banquet ticket for each of the inductees nominated who will be in attendance at the MSA annual Awards Banquet.
4. Induct any qualified individual who cannot attend the Awards Banquet, or is deceased at the MSA annual Awards Banquet.

PLAYER:

1. Person must have a minimum of 20 years of being active or was a member of the MSA.
2. Provide particulars, including years, division/teams, name/sponsors
3. Provide particulars, MSA Major tournaments including year, event and partners, if applicable (ie 1989 Mixed Doubles (Partners name)
4. Provide particulars for the fun Tournaments

BUILDER:

1. Person must have held offices/chairs at Provincial and/or National levels for a minimum of 5 years. Provide details in writing.

AND/OR

2. Person must have promoted our sport extensively (ie: involvement in organizing league play, tournaments, fund raising, recruitment of new players, new sponsorships, expansion of new establishment of shuffleboard, media awareness.)

PLAYER AND/OR BUILDER:

1. Provide a completed Induction form, which includes a written testimony of his or her contributions. Form must be signed by the Nomination Person as well as 17 other members of the MSA.
2. Player and /or Builder must be in good standing with his or here Charter for a minimum of 20 years. Confirmation to be provided in writing by the current President of the MSA.
3. Supply a minimum of 1 – 8 x 10 photo of inductee (video, DVD optional)
4. Submit all requirements noted above to the MSA Hall of Fame Committee, six (6) months prior to the MSA annual Awards Banquet.

A decision will be made by the MSA, HOF Committee three (3) months prior to the MSA annual Awards Banquet. There will be a maximum of three (3) players and one (1) builder inducted each year.

Selected candidates will be honored at the year's MSA Awards Banquet.

Any candidates not selected shall be kept on file for at least three (3) years and may be reconsidered by the HOF Committee at a later date.

Induction into the MSA Hall of Fame shall be final and forever with honour and without prejudice.
